Medication Assistants (MAC) are health care specialists trained to administer medications under the supervision of a registered nurse. MACs can work in a variety of settings, including long-term care facilities, home health and assisted living agencies, correctional institutions, and urgent care settings. Upon completing the course requirements, the MAC Candidates are eligible to sit for the National (MACE) Certification Exam.

- Current TB Skin Test
- At least 17 years old
- Current CPR/BLS
- Native Drug screen
- COVID Vaccine
